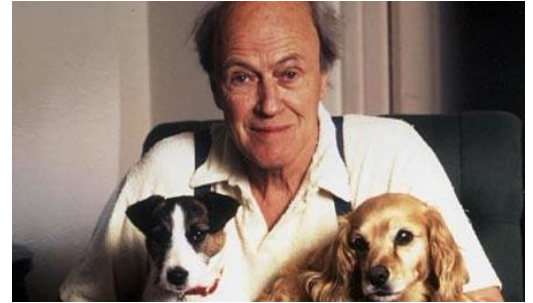
In this project the children will learn:

- Impact of the Greeks on the modern world

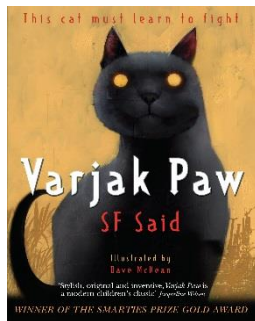


Literacy

The literacy focus for this half term will be biographies. We will be using Pie Corbett's teaching methods to memorise a biography all about Roald Dahl. This term we will also be reading 'Varjack Paw' by Cressida Cowell and we encourage all our children to read a number SF Said books. These books are available in our classroom reading corner and there are eight books available to read in the 'Dazzle Box' in our classroom.



Reciprocal Reading



Our amazing Reciprocal Reading is every morning at 8.30. This term we are reading 'Varjack Paw'.

We are using reciprocal reading to improve children's understanding of texts.

Maths



It is expected that all children are able to fluently recall up to their 12 times table by the end of year 4, so we shall be continuing to develop the children's mental maths skills and ability to recall key maths facts.

Our focus time tables are the 8 and 9 times table this half term.

This half term our focus in maths will be fractions, decimals and time.

Science



Our focus for science this half term will be Electricity. We will be covering the dangers of electricity, to know how to run appliances on electricity, to recognise simple components, to construct a simple circuit and to find materials out what materials conduct electricity.

We will be continuing to build on children's scientific language and knowledge.
