


Tanzanite and Peridot - Year 2 – Summer 1


Reading

We are then going to be working really hard as we will be completing many independent writing tasks using all of the skills we have learnt across the year.

Maths


This half term we will be revisiting lots of different areas of maths including shapes, mental arithmetic and fractions of amounts, as well as lots of practise with the four number operations: +, -, x and ÷. Try to get your child to have a go at these skills at home. You could ask them questions about their times tables (What is 2x5?) or have a go at dividing by sharing out objects in your house. It will also help your child to talk about the time, asking them to say what time they are going to bed, eating dinner or starting school.

Topic

We will be continuing with the topic Mini Zoo. Children will be exploring the animals of other countries

Science

Our topic this half term is plants. We will be investigating how plants grow and what they need to survive. We will be completing our own seed diary and following the progress of our own sunflower.
